Thank you for the opportunity to review the draft report titled *Archaeological Monitoring Report, Kalaeloa Airport Hanger 110 Renovation Phase 3, Honouliuli Ahupua'a, 'Ewa District, O'ahu TMK: [1] 1-9-013:088, 089, 103, and 032 por.* (Rivera and Monahan, June 2016). The State Historic Preservation Division (SHPD) received this submittal on June 28, 2016. The archaeological monitoring plan (AMP) (Inglis et al. 2014) was accepted on February 6, 2014 (Log No. 2013.6865, Doc. No. 1401SL29).

The archaeological monitoring report (AMR) was prepared at the request of Close Construction, Inc. The landowner is the State of Hawai'i Department of Transportation Airports Division. The project area is approximately 5.0 acres and is located near Barbers Point within the Kalaeloa Airport along the northern edge of Runway 11. The original AMP was prepared for the overall Kalaeloa Hangar 110 utility improvements for a 24.0 acre project area; however, the current AMR reflects work monitoring for the Phase 3 portion of construction. The majority of construction activities monitored consist of utility line excavations for sewer, water, electrical, and drainage lines.

The archaeological monitoring was conducted between November 18, 2015 and March 8, 2016. The report provides a total of 18 representative stratigraphic profiles. The general stratigraphy consists of fill layers overlying natural deposits, primarily the coral shelf, in the eastern and western sides of Hangar 110. The northern and southern sides of the hangar exhibited more extensive historic fill layers that are likely associated with the area's development and installation of utilities. The observed excavations typically extended beyond 2.0 meters in depth, with several extending to 3.0 meters. The water table was not encountered. No surface or subsurface historic properties were identified during the course of archaeological monitoring.

The AMR is well written and meets the requirements stipulated in Hawaii Administrative Rules (HAR) §13-279-5. **It is accepted by SHPD.** Please send one hardcopy of the document, clearly marked FINAL, along with a copy of this review letter to our Kapolei Office, attention SHPD Library. 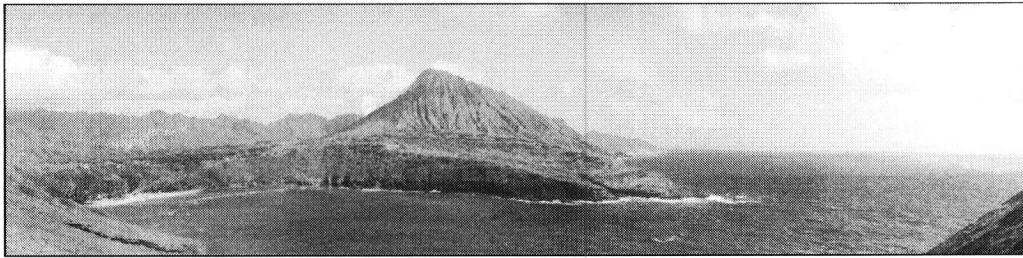
