11:39 am, J. Villaro was in section 12A when called by C. Au to 12C for help. Upon arrival, vendor employee M. Saiki (S) and daily vendor J. Thompson (T) were yelling at each other regarding early morning incidents outside Aloha Stadium Swap Meet. J. Villaro advised both S. and T to stop or risk possible Trespass. (S) proceeded to walk toward his stand at 12C05 while (T) walked the other way. Villaro followed (S) to investigate further, upon reaching (S) stall, there was loud yelling involving the neighboring vendor (N) across from (S). 11:41 Villaro called box 6 for State Security. Response came from State worker (Kim) to confirm sending HPD and State Security.

11:50 am, HPD off duty officer arrived, and individually talked to both vendors. No further action was taken. 12:25 pm HPD off duty officer left.

M. Saiki stated that (S) cut him off and did not even apologize. Upset the (S) did not care and continued to drive off.

J. Thompson stated that he did not know that he cut off (S) on the road. (T) said that he did not acknowledge (S) because (T) was afraid (S) might do something violent.
